The theme of this year's competition is Biophilia, so all artwork submitted should celebrate a connection with life in some way. Artwork can be created in any medium and can be any category including fine art, moving digital pieces and graphic illustrations.

Applications open on Wednesday 1st June 2022 and close on Friday 30th September.
